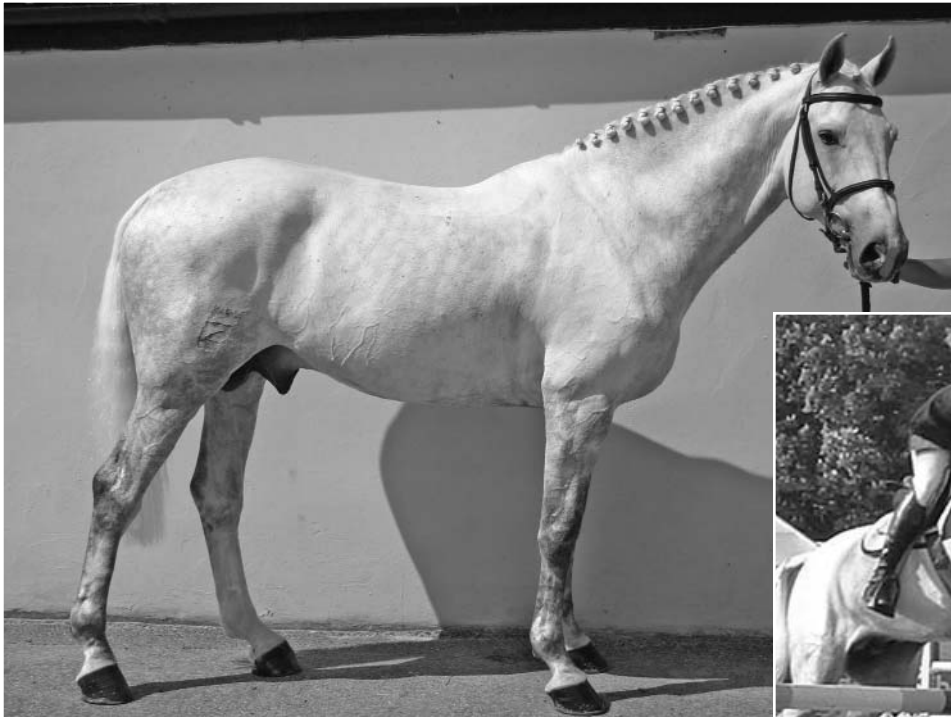


CEVIN Z



PEDIGREE

- CEVIN Z's pedigree features the outstanding bloodlines for which the Zangersheide Studbook is famous, with double crosses of both Cor de la Bryere (3 x 4) and Capitol I (3 x 3). Cevin Z was the highest priced foal at the Zangersheide auction in 1997.
- HIS SIRE, Coriall Z, is one of the top stallions of the Zangersheide Stud, with a BLUP of 127 for show jumping as well as two graded sons. He is the 3/4 brother to the well-known show jumping stallion Corrado I, sire of Indorado.
- HIS DAM, Larthago, is an international show jumper. She won a major international class at the Horse of the Year Show in 2003, as well as the CSI-A CHIO Rotterdam (1m45). Her progeny have brought very high prices in Europe. Her embryos have been sold for more than 25,000 Euros.
- HIS DAM SIRE, Carthago Z, is one of the most successful sons of Capitol I. He competed in the 1996 and 2000 Olympics, successfully combining a competition career with a successful stud career, and, from three crops sired nine graded sons, with over 100 progeny competing in show jumping with winnings of over 40,000 pounds.

PERFORMANCE

- CEVIN Z was the highest priced foal at the Zangersheide Stud auction in 1997. He has been brought along slowly by rider William Funnell, and started competing in 2001. Cevin Z finished 4th in the Foxhunter Championship at the Horse of the Year Show in 2003 (the British Young Jumper Championships). He spent virtually all of 2004 at stud, with a book of over 40 mares, which allowed him to mature. He competed lightly in 2005, and then had a bye competition season in 2006, upgrading from Grade C to Grade A. Early in the year, he finished 2nd in the Grade B/C Championships at the Royal Windsor Show. His steady success has continued, and William plans to start him in International level classes this winter.

PROGENY

- CEVIN Z stamps his progeny with his excellent temperament and athleticism. His foals are 6-year-olds in 2007. From his limited first crop (he was only bred to a few mares the first year), he had the 1st and 2nd placed horses at the British 5-year-old Young Horse Classic Showjumping Championships!
